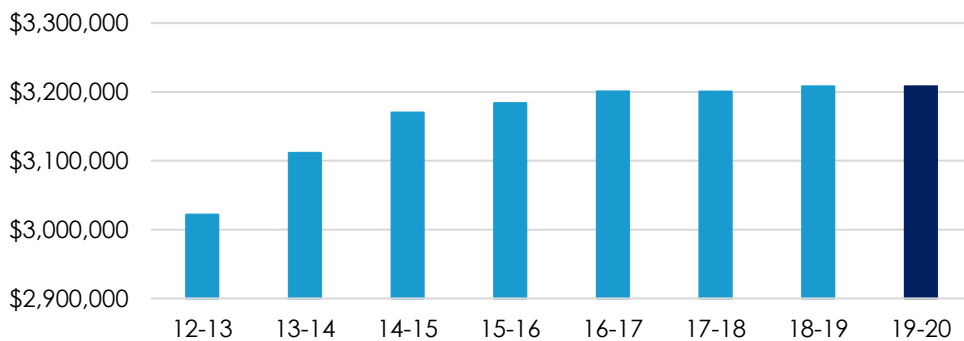

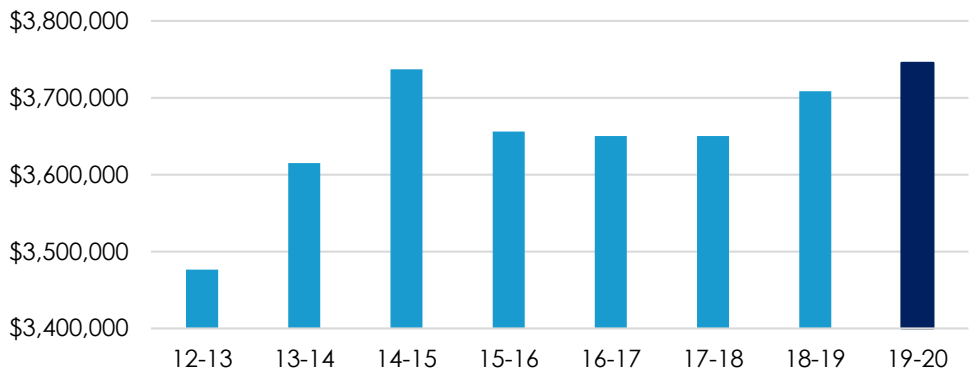

### History of FI School Annual Budgets

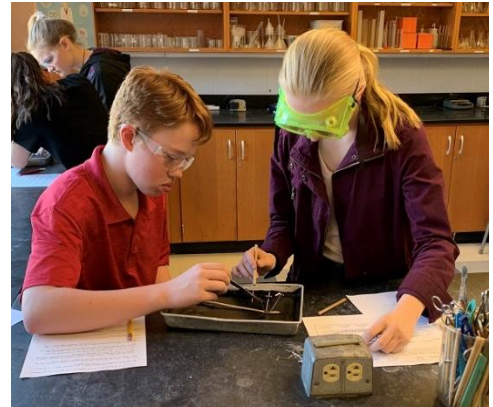

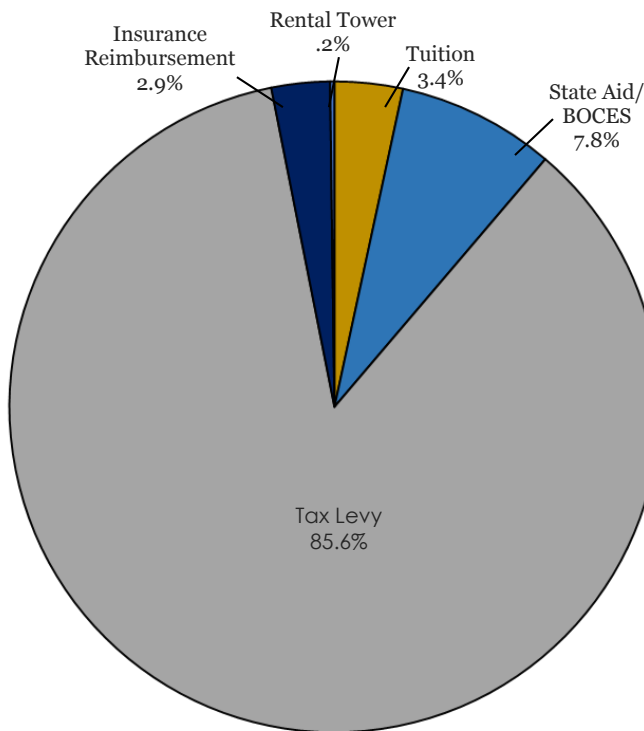

## Important Information

### Absentee Ballots

To apply for an absentee ballot, voters simply complete an application setting forth the following: (1) name and address, (2) that he/she is qualified to vote, and (3) that he/she is unable to appear to vote for one of several reasons. Those wishing to apply for an Absentee Ballot may do so by contacting Leslie Tombari, District Clerk at 631-788-7444 or by visiting the school's main office.

Completed applications must be received by the District Clerk at least seven (7) days before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before the election if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter. Completed Absentee Ballots must be received by the District Clerk not later than 5:00PM on Monday, April 20, 2019.

### Voter Requirements

- Citizen of the United States
- Legal Resident\* on or before April 21, 2019
- 18 years old on or by May 21, 2019

\*Proof of Residency (requires one of the following):

- Voter name appears on the Fishers Island Election Roll from the Suffolk County Board of Elections
- A driver's license with a Fishers Island address
- A non-driver New York State identification card with a Fishers Island address.

NOTE: Having voted in previous FIUFSD election(s) does not in and of itself qualify a person in a current election.

**Proposition #1:** Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit: RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Fishers Island Union Free School District #4, Fishers Island, New York, be and is authorized to expend the sum of \$3,745,543 for the 2019-2020 school year set forth in the estimate of General Fund appropriations, and hereby is authorized to levy the necessary tax therefore.

**Proposition #2:** Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit: RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Fishers Island Union Free School District #4, Fishers Island, New York, be and is authorized to collect on behalf of the Fishers Island Library Association \$51,000 for use of and by the Fishers Island Library Association, and is hereby authorized to levy the necessary tax therefore.
